Contact information is extremely important. Messages can be quickly sent to you via email, but your mailing address is needed to receive the Statement of Entry, instructions for examination days, and to receive the final grades and CIE Certificate. Please make sure you keep all correspondence from NAMED SCHOOL in a safe place.

The UCI (Unique Candidate Identifier) is given to all candidates, and consists of 12 digits and a letter. This is originally given to a candidate that is taking IGCSEs or A Levels for the first time. If you have already sat examinations at another centre, you will have a UCI attached to your name. You need to inform us of the UCI so that we can continue to make your examination entries under that number. This will allow CIE to put all of your marks together.

If you have not sat CIE examinations before, you will not have a Candidate Number. That will be assigned to you, and you will see it on your Statement of Entry, along with our school's Centre Number. Each examination that you sit will require your unique Candidate Number, as well as the Centre Number. So make sure you know your numbers!

If, due to special circumstances, you have previously been given additional time to complete examinations, you must inform NAMED SCHOOL at the time of registration. Supporting documentation for additional time allowances is also expected at this time.

As NAMED SCHOOL is a CIE Centre in the USA, the only examination board that should be entered is Cambridge (CIE). If you are doing examinations using another board's syllabus (e.g. Edexcel, OCR, AQA), NAMED SCHOOL cannot take your registration form.

Some examinations have a Core or Extended Tier at IGCSE level. If there is a choice of Tier for a particular subject, please indicate whether you are taking Core or Extended IGCSE papers. This choice must also coincide with the Paper choices that you indicate you are taking in the Examination Paper Choices box.

Unit codes for each syllabus that you are sitting are found in each syllabus, along with the course name. Please check the code carefully before entering it into the form, as many of the unit codes are similar. NAMED SCHOOL cannot be held responsible for mistakes made on the registration form.
